

Give me a holiday, stat!

It's awfully cold in Finland, but employees there can warm up to the fact that their country offers its workers as many as **30 days** of statutory holiday a year, according to a global comparison of holiday entitlements released by Mercer.

A stat holiday is the amount of paid leave that companies must, by law, offer their staff. And while there is no statutory minimum in the U.S., employees typically receive **15 days** a year.
